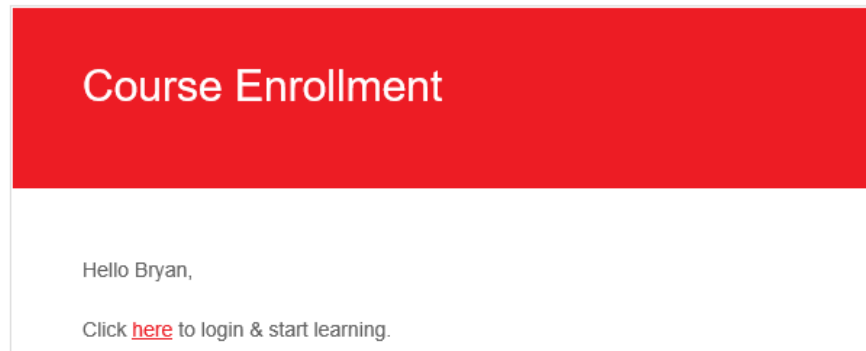

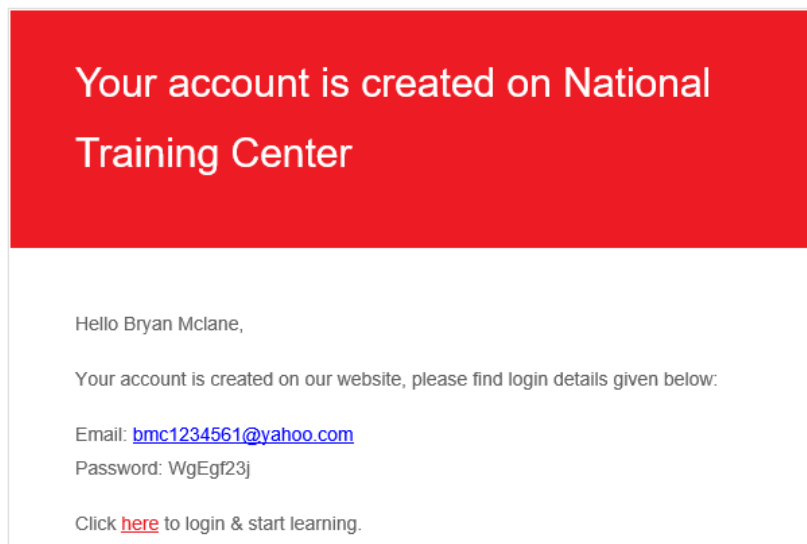
When you purchase WECA Training, you will receive an enrollment email from NationalTrainingCenter.com advising that you now have access to the WECA Training.

- 1. If you already have an account on NationalTrainingCenter.com, you will receive an email confirmation that WECA has given you access to the training:**

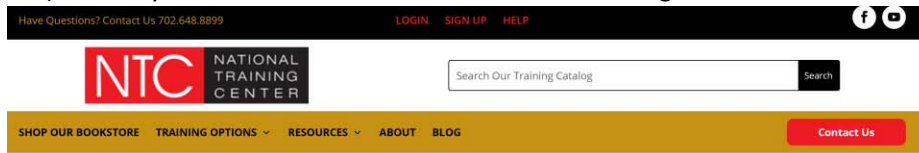


- 2. If you do NOT have an account on NationalTrainingCenter.com, you will receive an email informing you an account has been set up for you with a temporary password for you to login.**

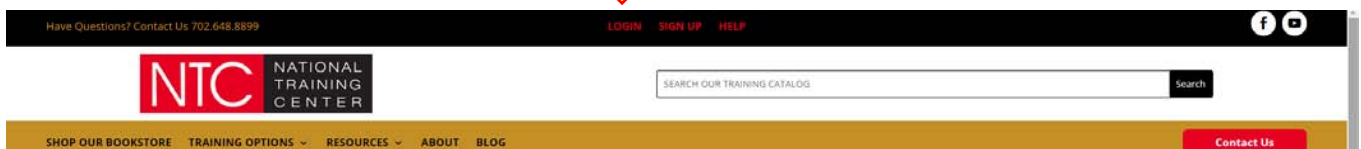
